In the first paper on “**Information Needs and Seeking Behaviour of Engineering College Faculty in Digital Era–A Study**” the author *Sasikala* has studied the information needs and information seeking behaviour of the engineering and technology faculty members of some selected institutions. The main intention of this study is to analyse the types of information sources used by the faculty members, their preferred information formats, the importance of and reasons for using certain information sources and the use of various formal, informal and electronic information sources.
