

## **Editorial**

We bring the first issue of the **Journal of Information Organization** with the research explained below.

In the first paper, “**Examining the Level of Information Literacy among First-Year English Students at the University of Sargodha**”, the authors studied the users’ information literacy skills who use English as the primary communication at a selected university. The authors have distributed the questionnaire to solicit the data. This study showed that undergraduates at the studied institution must learn more about using information.

In the following paper on “**Health and safety data analysis of the population using injury data**”, the authors studied the injuries of the population in the selected region to understand health and safety. The authors have investigated the nature and number of injuries by analysing the documents from the safety and health investigators of the region. Further, they classified the collected data and analysed the business entity.

In the last paper on “**GPS data conversion and analysis for tapping animal movement**”, the authors deployed tracking tags to tap the movement of wild animals. The proposed device uses ultra-low power, a minor form of the GPS receiver that helps the correct object identification. Moreover, they used the auxiliary motion sensors with a gyro accelerometer for data recording. The data is recorded to arrive at meaningful inferences.
