In the first paper on "Using the Information Literacy Model for Information Literacy Instruction: A Case Study" the author *Marzieh Siamak* has proposed a new information literacy model and tested with target population. The author has correlated skills and literacy and found positive links. The model after testing found to be more valid as the testing data confirmed it.

Mahdi Alhaji Musa and Mohd Shahizan Othman in the second paper on "Critical Success Factor in Business Process Reengineering In Healthcare: An Exploratory Investigations" have critically examined the success factors for business process reengineering. The results revealed that measurement of effectiveness of IT on the BPR is the most critical success factor for BPR implementation.
