Finding accurate and correct information from web is a major task and we have numerous studies that addressed this issue. In the first paper on **Extremely Pertinent Document Assortment from Disseminated Databases** the authors *Ahmad Alkhodre, Turki Alghamdi* and *Mohammad Husain* have proposed a very generic framework on a broad area supported with good architectures. They proposed an interface approach for linking heterogeneous databases in web.

In the next paper on **Temporal extension of the Select statement**, the authors have outlined with the principles of temporal data modelling on object and attribute level. Further they have described the characteristics of Select statement used in temporal system and further extended it with new characteristics and defined new layer for transformation into existing syntax.

Byungrae Cha and *Sujeong Shim* in the next paper on **Honeypot Service based on Cloud against DDoS to support VoIP Service** proposed an anomaly detection stage is performed to detect new DDoS attacks by unsupervised learning algorithm. Using cloud computing they described the multistage anomaly detection scheme to DDoS attacks.

In the last paper on **Didactic VR Model in Bridge Construction**, the authors proposed a geometric model 4D (3D +time) in a Virtual Reality (VR) environment which simulates the construction of a bridge deck composed of precast beams was implemented. The proposed VR application is currently used to support Bridge classes.

The published papers are incremental to further research.
