We present the first issue of the sixth volume of the **Journal of Science & Technology Metrics**, which includes the research below.

The authors of the first paper, “**Navigating Scholarly Literature with ResearchRabbit: A Comprehensive Analysis**,” studied *ResearchRabbit*’s functionality and features, using characteristics such as personalised citation-based recommendations, interactive visualisations, collaboration tools, and integration with reference management software. They analysed how the literature review process is utilised to enhance the efficiency and quality of research. They compared it with traditional literature search methods and found that it significantly reduces the time and effort required for literature reviews, enabling researchers to uncover relevant publications.

In the second paper, “**The impact of the Russia-Ukraine War on Scientific Circles**”, the author studied the trends in how and to what extent aspects of the Russo-Ukrainian War have been disseminated in scientific circles. She analysed the authors’ circle, geographical locations, and research topics. The ultimate aim is to find the impact of war on scientific publications.

In the last paper, “**Scientometric Mapping of the Research Productivity of Top NIRF-Ranked Universities in Delhi**,” the authors mapped the research productivity of Delhi-based universities that rank among the top in the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2023. They analysed the citations, high-volume publications, collaborations, and prolific institutions.

We hope that the papers of this issue mark elegance and significance in approach.
