In the opening paper on “**Measuring Noise in the Printing System**” the authors measured the noise and its influence in the printing process. In this paper, the authors have measured the two kinds of printing so as to receive the inferences about controlling noise. It is an extensive work from the authors.

In the next paper on “**Skew Detection and Correction System for Ancient Kannada Documents**” the authors proposed a skew correction method for ancient Kannada documents which includes segmentation, clustering, skew estimation and correction. Authors resorted to the experimentation process on the seventeen ancient Kannada document for which a few professionals are asked to acquire the orientation of each block present in the document.

In the last paper on “**Analysing the Transmission of Warning Message in the Web-Based Applications**” the authors considered the service description and the implementation aspects. In the work, the next generation application protocols are related to the warning message transmission which is reflected as service and help more flexible deployment.
