In the first paper on "**Study the Impact of Multiple Mobile Sinks on the lifetime of Wireless Sensor Networks**" the authors *Zubaria Andleeb* and *Rizwan Anjum* have presented the simulation based analysis of using multiple mobile sinks in network and their effect on the lifetime of a network. Their intention is to analyse the impact of multiple mobile sinks with proactive hierarchical clustering protocols LEACH and network reactive hierarchical protocol.

In the second paper on "**A Cloud-based Transcoding with Partial Content Protection Scheme**" the authors presented an effective multimedia content protection technique that removes the need to decrypt the video prior to transcoding. The authors claim that the proposed scheme significantly simplifies cloud-based processing compared to previous schemes.

They have supported the proposed TQM Model with an implementation plan that could help other Syrian banks to apply TQM in an effective way.
